

## Drinking water in HOFOR – Copenhagen

HOFOR is responsible for the quality of the drinking water from the moment it is pumped from the water works and until it is delivered to the property line. From then on, the property's owner is responsible for the quality of the drinking water, until it reaches the water taps on the property. In relation to Copenhagen Malmø Port (CMP), HOFOR is thus responsible for delivering drinking water to CMP's property line.

In executive order No. 1024 of October 31, 2011 on "Water Quality and Surveillance of Water Supply Units", the Danish Ministry of the Environment has laid down requirements regarding as to what drinking water may contain, and how for the person responsible to monitor that the water quality is complied with.

HOFOR supplies high quality drinking water and has a very thorough control program which ensures that the water quality is correct - at any time. Seven regional water works supply drinking water to the customers in Copenhagen. At these water works, HOFOR is certified according to ISO 22000 on Food Safety and in addition to that, since 2008, HOFOR has been operating according to Documented Drinking Water Safety (DDS).

The municipality, in this case Copenhagen Municipality, is the regulatory authority and must thus monitor that the requirements laid down are complied with.
