

To the Captain

Dear Sir,

I address you because of complaints from residents at Langelinie, regarding noise and emissions from cruise calls.

To avoid complications to the detriment of the cruise, we kindly ask You to be aware of the following points during your stay in Port of Copenhagen.

- Using the loudspeaker on open decks should be avoided. That means no firedrills before 9 o'clock in the morning, no open air cinema and no unnecessary loudspeaker calls.
- Use of smoke emission from the chimney should be avoided. As you know, the EU Sulphur Directive is in force limited to 0,1 % sulphur in the fuel.
- Typhoon should only be used for navigational use and emergency testing.
- No use of noise mechanical maintenance tools.

Extract from the Statutory Order on Standard Regulations for the Observance of Good Order in Danish Commercial Ports: Prohibited activities: 4) Activities that involve unnecessary smoke, dust, smell or noise, including unnecessary use of sirens and whistles.

We appreciate your understanding and look forward to a good season, where both cruise ships and residents will find their stay enjoyable at Langelinie.
